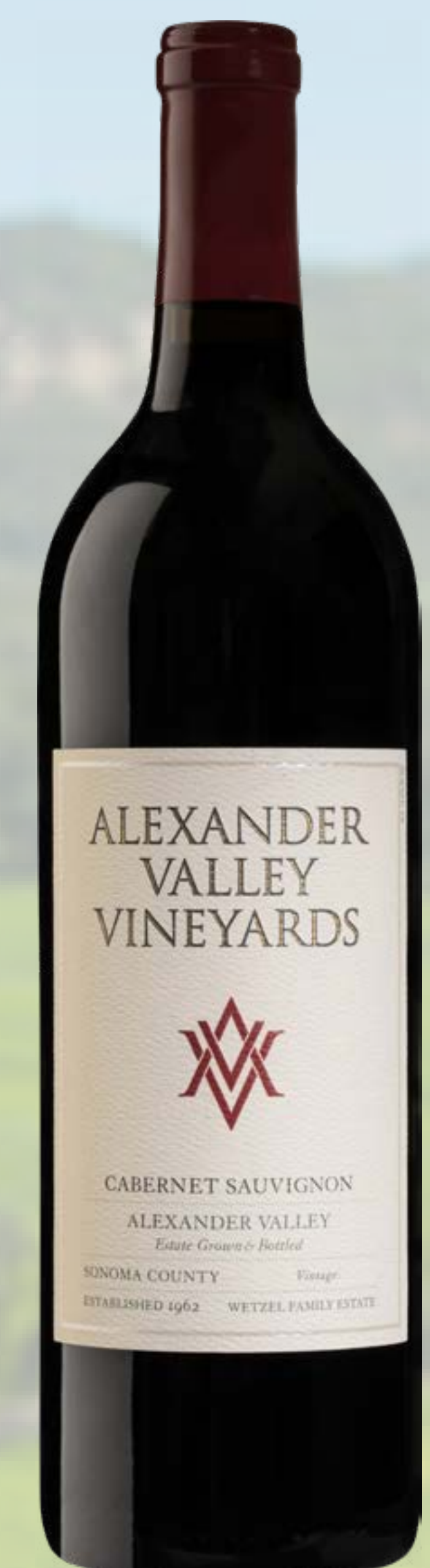

ABOUT THE WINERY

Alexander Valley Vineyards is located on Highway 128 in northern Sonoma County, 75 miles north of San Francisco, 6 miles from the sleepy town of Healdsburg & 16 miles from Calistoga in the Napa Valley. Sonoma County's Alexander Valley was mostly prune orchards & pastures when, in 1962, Maggie & Harry Wetzel purchased a large portion of a homestead built by Cyrus Alexander, the valley's nineteenth century namesake.

Here, in a rural community of family farms & ranches, the Wetzel family settled. They raised livestock, cultivated bountiful gardens & restored Alexander's original home, making it the center of family life. With an eye to their neighbors in nearby Napa Valley, the Wetzels boldly planted premium grape varieties, among the first in the area. Then the family built a small winery & Hank Wetzel, oldest son of Maggie & Harry, produced Alexander Valley Vineyard's first wine in 1975. His wife Linda set up the books & managed the winery office. AVV quickly established a reputation for estate grown wines with distinctive varietal character. Alexander Valley Vineyards brought recognition to the appellation & became a leading winery in Sonoma County.

Today the Alexander Valley is a prominent appellation known worldwide as the source of rich, age worthy wines. Our 720 acres estate is home to diverse micro-climates, stretching from the banks of the Russian River up onto the hillsides. Vineyard Manager Isaul Macias & Winemaker Kevin Hall work as a team to maximize fruit flavor in the vineyard & to create balanced wines that capture the grapes' varietal characteristics.

We've spent decades perfecting our grape growing and winemaking, every bottle we produce reflects our heritage and each glass of wine shares our story.

ABOUT THE WINERY

In the heart of the famous Veneto region in northern Italy at the foot of the picturesque town of Montello, there is Cantina Montelliana. Since 1957, the 400 family owners of this small cooperative have been producing top quality Italian wines of the DOCG and DOC combining innovation and tradition in every step of the winemaking process for over 50 years.

With member landownership only averaging 3 acres, the selection of grapes are grown on the Montello and Asolo hills at an altitude of 400 to 600 feet above sea level, are all situated on southern exposures. These exceptional vineyards of this extraordinary land, between the hills and flat areas have unique organoleptic characteristics and unparalleled, thanks to the favorable balance between the climate and the gravelly subsoil of this region. The cooperative's deep commitment to quality is shown in its continuous efforts to improve its production, storage and bottling facilities by searching out the latest and most advanced technology available thus receiving the ISO 9001 quality certificate.

This ensures the highest of quality, cleanliness and safety throughout the wine making process while maintaining the respectful traditional methods of the past that are closely linked to the history and culture of winemaking in the area. In 1980, the Angelini family embarked on a voyage to locate the highest quality Pinot Grigio, Pinot Noir and Merlot of this area and thus was born the Angelini selection of wines.

ABOUT THE WINERY

Carpenè Malvolti is one of the most ancient & prestigious houses noted for helping to form the great Italian wine making tradition. It was founded in 1868 by Antonio Carpenè, a forerunner in the application of biology (a then newly-acquired knowledge) to the art of wine making. Antonio, in contact with the great scientists of the century, Pasteur & Koch, published practical and theoretical tracts on the subject of wine making, which for many years were considered classical texts on the subject. In 1873, at Conegliano, he established the first Oenology school in Italy dedicated to the study of grape growing and wine making. Today's custodian of the family traditions and expertise is the great-grandson of the founder, Etilio Carpenè Jr.

ABOUT THE DISTILLERY

This distillery boasts extensive experience in the production of fine liquors. The family operated company follows the rigorous artisan production process that they have preserved and faithfully handed down over the past three generations. Limoncello is the pride of the establishment: its original fragrance brings forth the unique aromatic quality of the Verdelli lemons. These lemons are hand picked from the Amalfi coast, exclusively for the production of Limoncello. Then the zest of the lemons are peeled by hand, since they believe this is the only way to preserve the special fragrance imparted by the fruit and oils on the skins. The Russo family follows the old traditional recipe, giving their Limoncello the special terroir character of the Amalfi coast.



ABOUT THE WINERY

The Azienda Agricola Il Palagetto was founded in 1991 in San Gimignano and immediately distinguished itself for its effort to concentrate on quality. The famed Oenologist Tachis was the chosen wine maker. The farm is no longer a small local entity. It now encompasses over 200 acres all of which are located in Tuscany.

The activities taking place on the farm are varied and, along with wine, include the production of olive oil, honey and saffron; all of which are produced using the proper combination of traditional and modern methods. A bed and breakfast, using restored farmhouses, is operated on the premises. The entire Niccolai family, Fina, Luano and children Sabrina and Simone, are involved in the daily administration of the farm.

ABOUT THE WINERY

In 1838, Henry Delaroze, the owner of Châteaux Gruaud Larose and Château Larose Perganson, was mayor of Saint-Laurent du Médoc. As a great expert in Médoc crus he wanted to do something to make his mark, and so he created a new vineyard of 15.95 hectares on the land known as Trintaudon. It passed to Count Ernest de Lahens in 1858, a man of great ambition and vision, who developed the estate and extended it to some 345 hectares by 1872. Although his new cru Larose-Trintaudon rapidly rose to the ranks of a classified fifth cru, it was alas too late to be included in the 1855 classification of the wines of Bordeaux, a classification that would never be revised.

But Larose-Trintaudon was in step with the times and chose to win the hearts of the people. The experts made no mistake when they awarded it medal after medal... at the Bordeaux International Exposition of 1885, the World Expo in Paris in 1889, and the Amsterdam World Fair in 1884. It was listed as a Cru Bourgeois in the 1868 edition of Féret, then a Cru Bourgeois Supérieur in 1874. And in 1884, at the height of his success, Lahens commissioned the construction of the chateau of Trintaudon, with its distinctive tower that remains the symbol of its popularity and its legend today.

ABOUT THE WINERY

Lussac-Saint-Emilion is the most northerly of the four 'satellites' within the larger Saint-Emilion appellation in the 'right bank' Libournais district of Bordeaux. The Lavie stream runs along the southwestern boundary of Lussac-Saint-Emilion, neatly separating it from Montagne-Saint-Emilion. To the southeast is the other satellite of Puisseguin-Saint-Emilion. To the east is the Cotes de Francs appellation. Beyond this, its northern limits border the wider Bordeaux AOP appellation which stretches all the way to the department's boundary with the Charente-Maritime. The landscape in Lussac is slightly higher and more rolling than that which prevails closer to the Dordogne, although a certain element of alluvial clay is still found in its soils.

ABOUT THE WINERY

The historical underground wine cellars of Coppo are a UNESCO World Heritage site. They are part of the network of underground cathedrals, a temple of wine dedicated to its history and the hard work of their history. Built beginning in the late 18th century, initially intended as small cellars to conserve wine, they were expanded from 1800-1900 to what they are today. The historical wine cellars of Coppo extend under the hill of Canelli for a total of 5 thousand square meters (16,400 ft) and a depth that reaches 40 meters (130 ft).

The history of Coppo winery is inextricably wound with the wine history of Piedmont. It is closely linked to the development of the city of Canelli, known as the capital of Italian sparkling wine and one of Italy's most important viticultural centers today. Coppo's history is one of tradition and courageous vision for the future, of sacrifice and innovation. It is a story of the unconditional love that Coppo has for their vines' origins, for varieties that have always been cultivated in Piedmont, and for old family traditions.

The origins of the winery date back to 1892. For over 120 years, the family has remained the sole owner. Since the very beginning, the Coppo family has managed estate vineyards and bottled their own wine under the name of Coppo, making it one of the oldest family-run wineries in all of Italy. In fact, in 2012, Unioncamere added the winery to the national register of historical businesses, highlighting its uninterrupted activity for over a century in the commodity market.

ABOUT THE WINERY

This beautiful estate and vineyard are located in the heart of Provence. The estate combines a best of the people, traditions and nature to consistently produce great wine. The Chateau Montaud vines are grown on long schist and sandstone terraces in the heart of the Maures Mountains. The chateau is situated on the site of an old Roman "villa" the remains were found during the restructuring of the vineyard. For three generations, the Ravel family have carried on their traditions. Their iconic Chateau Montaud rosé is packaged in a Provencal bottle specially made more than 40 years ago for the Ravel family.

Chateau Montaud is home to Vignobles Francois Ravel, a family-owned company founded in 1964. Little by little, the family created a viticultural estate that today is one of the most important in the Provence region. The Domaine's Permian soils are poor and thus require the vines to take root deeply; this allows them to benefit from the full characteristics of the land. Production adheres to the principles of low yields, no irrigation, and harvest at the point of perfect ripeness, advanced technology, and noble traditions.

ABOUT THE WINERY

The Domaine du Colombier has been a family property since 1887, handed down over several generations. In 1957 Guy MOTHE started to specialize in Chablis. Today his three sons Jean-Louis, Thierry and Vincent work the 55 hectares of vines. These vines are planted exclusively to Chardonnay, most of the vineyards are dedicated to the production of AC Chablis, though there are significant holdings in Premier Cru Fourchaume and Grand Cru Bourgros. This is a first-class source of pure, unoaked, mineral-laden AC Chablis.

The winemaking is carried out with great care, with the greatest of respect for the traditional Burgundian methods, allied to the advantages of modern techniques. The estate vineyards range in age from 5-50 years old. They operate very naturally and use Organic manure, rigorous tying up, de-budding and green harvest if necessary. The Domaine started to sell in bottle in the middle of the 1980's. Today it produces 430 000 bottles of which 80% are exported.

ABOUT THE WINERY

The Castellani Family produce classic wines in Tuscany since more than 150 years. Every generation continually experiment with their vineyards & cellars in order to select the best Tuscan wines to be bottled under the family brand.

Exporters of wine since 1903, the Castellani family have founded their high-quality wines on the belief that "the quality of the wine starts in the vineyard". For the past 25 years, the family has worked hard to refine the soil types & microclimates that enhance their 'great Tuscan vines', investing in research & new technologies to ensure the Castellani name continues to be associated with 'memorable wines'.

A believer in maintaining the balance between nature & the modern world, Piergiorgio & his family reside in the middle of one of his vineyards, which helps influence the personal closeness he feels to the wine his family makes. The special conditions, both climatic & cultural, that exist in Tuscany already offer everything a winemaker needs, but that could quickly change if the land they cultivate is not cared for.

It's this 360-degree commitment to the environment that enables Piergiorgio to produce high-quality wines year after year. He renounces using chemical treatments & is continually updating his vineyards to maintain organic & natural farming techniques. This confluence between traditional winemaking practices, modern technological advances, & a deep reverence & appreciation for nature fuels the Castellani family's continued success in producing incredible, robust Italian wines.

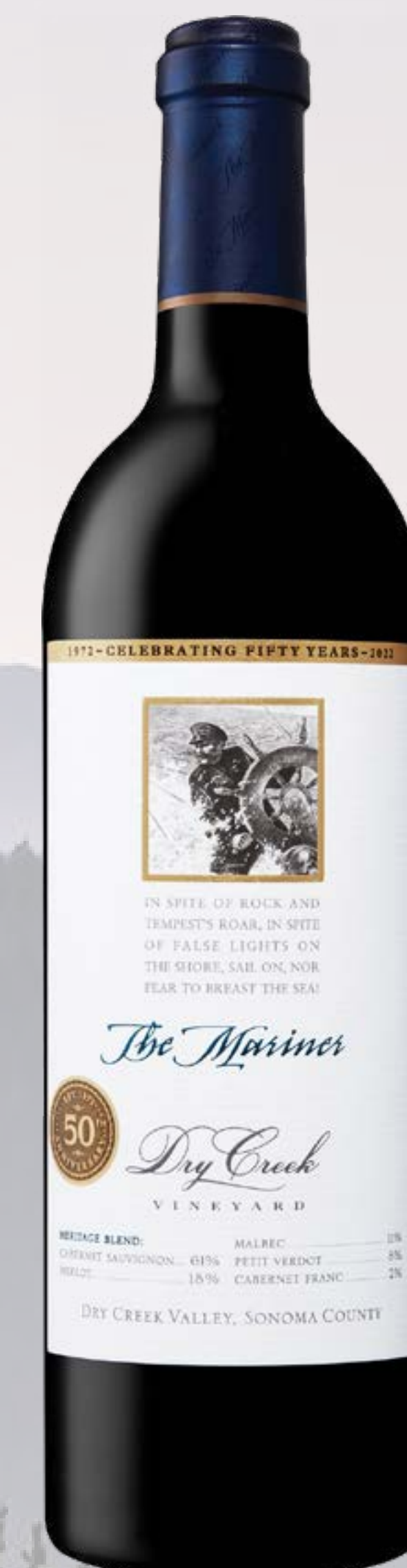

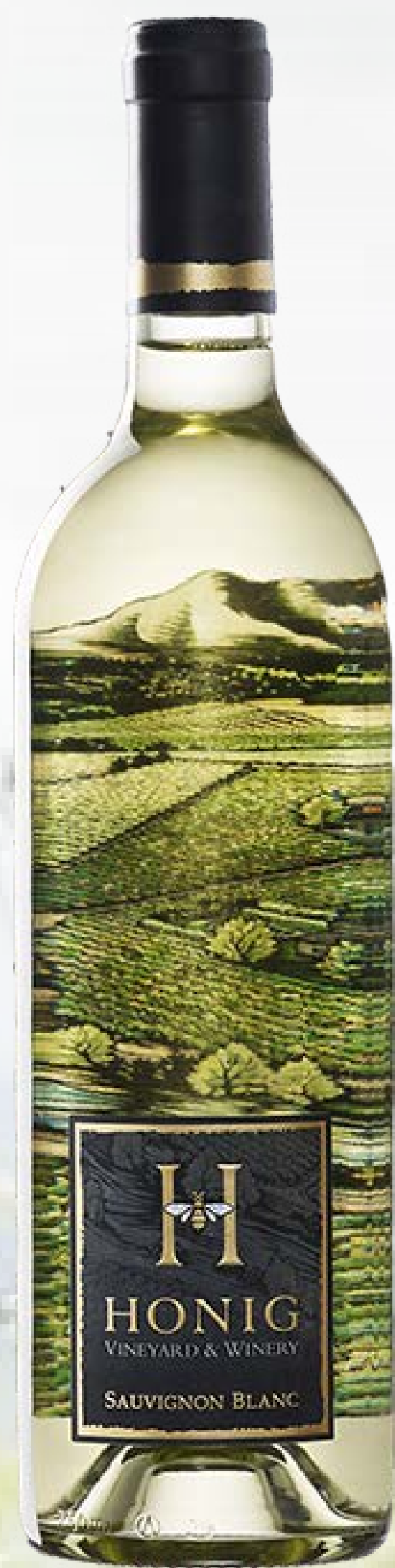

ABOUT THE WINERY

We purchased our Rutherford Vineyard in 1964, and began producing wine in 1980. In 1984, at the age of 22, Michael Honig took over management of the vineyard and winery. With the help of a handful of family members and a staff of dedicated employees, what began as a small "garage" winery has today become a successful family enterprise, with everyone working collaboratively to run an inspiring and socially responsible business.

1964 — Louis Honig purchased a 68-acre ranch in Rutherford, in the heart of the Napa Valley. The vineyard was planted with Sauvignon Blanc and Cabernet Sauvignon grapes, which he sold to neighboring wineries. Louis worked to create a family gathering place at the ranch, for his children and grandchildren, while he dreamed of the day he could retire from his San Francisco advertising agency and make wine from his vineyard.

1980 — Louis passed away before he could realize his dream, leaving the estate to his family. In 1980, as a tribute to his legacy, his family produced a few hundred cases of Louis Honig Sauvignon Blanc in the vineyard's old tractor barn. After the wine won a Gold Medal at the Orange County Fair, the family decided to increase production, and Honig Vineyard & Winery was born.

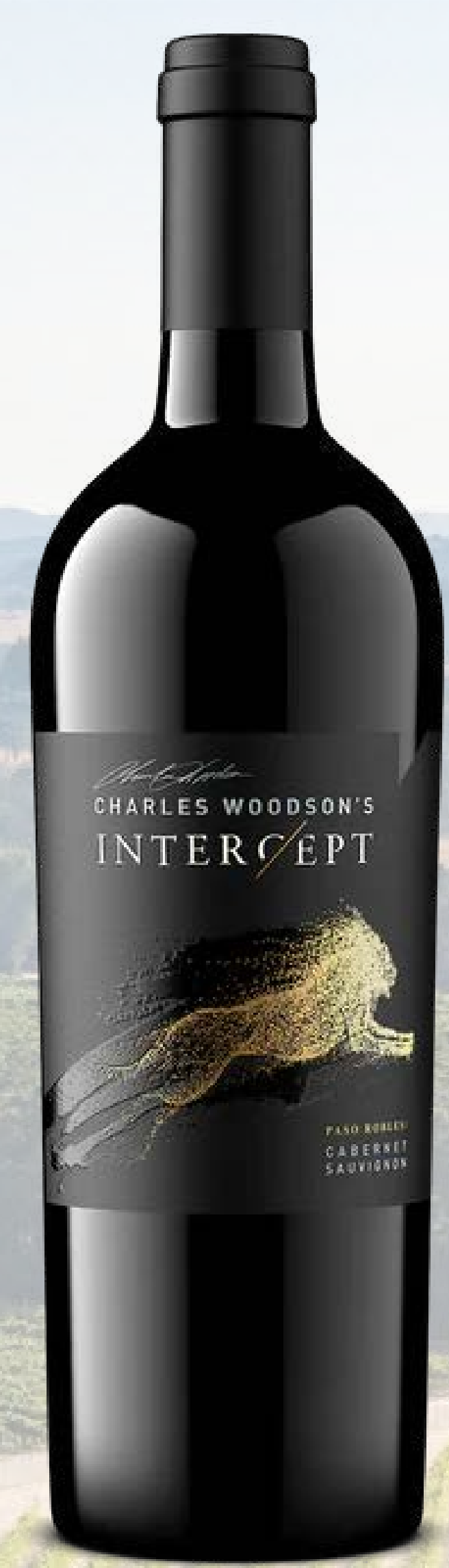
1984 — At the age of 22, grandson Michael Honig took over management of the vineyard and winery. In 1989 the family began producing small amounts of Cabernet Sauvignon. As the business grew, family members Regina Weinstein, Steven Honig, and Rapha Cruz joined Michael in the winery.

In 2019, he launched Charles Woodson's Intercept Wines, and in 2020 became the first Black Pro-Football player to achieve national distribution on a wine brand. Even with all his history, Charles says he's just getting started.

ABOUT THE WINERY

We've always been most at home on the edges. In 1973, Nicholas Molnar planted Poseidon Vineyard at the southern extreme of Napa Carneros, on what had been grazing land since the time of the missionaries. He was among the first to farm this area which at the time was considered too cool to ripen wine grapes. For three decades, he grew chardonnay & pinot noir for the top sparkling wine houses in Napa Valley.

In the beginning, there were three of us: Michael Terrien, Peter Molnar & Arpad Molnar. Twenty years ago, we ventured north, planting a vineyard on an old abandoned walnut orchard a half mile in the sky. We soon discovered that we were farming on a volcano, on a ridge of solid black Obsidian glass. Today, the extreme climate, altitude, & volcanics result in a cabernet sauvignon like no other.

Our winemaker, Alex Beloz, has crafted our wines for more than a decade using barrels made from Tokaj oak by Kádár Hungary, the cooperage we have owned for nearly three decades.

Our story is one of heritage & innovation. The greatest lesson we've learned is that our legacy is one of adventuring off the beaten path. This is where we continue to learn, grow, & appreciate the simple pleasures of good wine with good people in wondrous natural settings.
